



Oak Grange Primary School Nursery Admissions Arrangements

Oak Grange Primary and Nursery School welcomes applications for Nursery from parents who would like a place for their child aged between 3 years and 4 years (prior to starting in a Reception class in a school).

Please see the time line below.

If places remain, school will continue to process applications		

Applications received after the closing date.

Applications received by the school after the deadline date of 31st March will be considered if places remain. The criteria below will be applied.

Over-Subscription Criteria

If the nursery is oversubscribed, after the admission of pupils with a Statement of Special Educational Need, or an Education Health and Care Plan (EHC) where the school is named in the Statement or EHCP, priority for admission will be given to those children who meet the criteria set out below, in order:

1. Looked after children and all previously looked after children, including those children who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.
2. Children who live within the current catchment area served by the school with brothers or sisters attending the school at the proposed time of their admission.
3. Other children living in catchment - applications will be assessed from the address the parents are living at the closing date and will be reassessed on the National Offer Date.
4. Brothers or sisters of children still attending the school at the time of their admission, but not living within the school's catchment area.
5. the school's catchment area. If places remain beyond criteria 4, then these will be allocated on proximity to the school measured 'as the crow flies' from the entrance to the child's home to the principal entrance of the main administrative building of the school.
6. Other children.

For the purposes of admissions, we class a brother or sister as:

- ❖ Having one or both natural parents in common.
- ❖ Being related by a parent's marriage or are adopted or fostered.

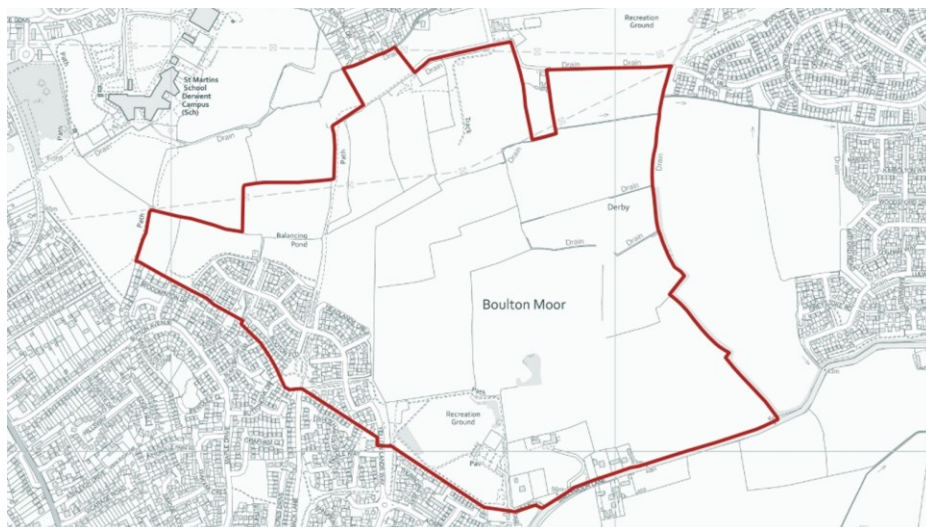

Note: a brother or sister must be living at the same address. Cousins are not classed as brothers or sisters.

Parents of Nursery children will be reminded of the need to apply for a place at a primary or infant school during the autumn term before their admission into a Reception class for the following September, via their Local Authority.

Note: A place at Oak Grange nursery does not guarantee a place into Reception at this school.

Nursery sessions are currently offered as follows:

Options		
Option 1	15hours AM Sessions	Mon – Fri 8:45-11:45am
Option 2	15hours PM Sessions	Mon – Fri 12:15-3:15pm
Option 3	30 hours ALL DAY	Mon – Fri 8:45-3:15pm*

*this option totals 32.5 hours, the remaining 2.5 hours are chargeable at £5.00 per hour (£12.50 per week)

If parents are eligible to receive 30 hours of funded childcare, they may select **Option 1 or 2** and use their remaining hours to top up with wrap around care via our **Oak Grangers** before and after school club.
