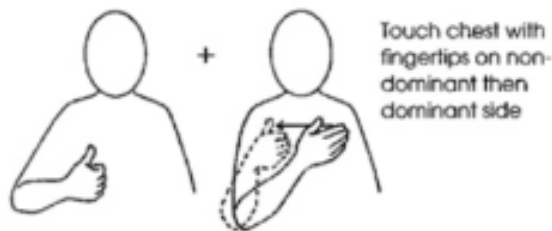

School uniform the children wear on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

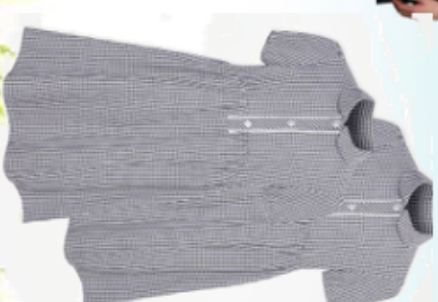
School Uniform

Oak Grange Uniform is as follows: (no requirement for nursery children)

- grey or black trousers
- grey pinafore or skirt
- white/black socks or black/navy/grey tights
- black, flat shoes .

- navy blue and white checked dresses
- grey shorts
